HEARINGS

<u>1. Farmland and Open Space Planned Residential Development Hearing - Century Mill</u> Estates

The Plan before the Board would create seventy-eight (78) lots on property located on Century Mill Road and Spectacle Hill Road. The lots are identified as 1-78 on a plan dated March 17, 2005 as prepared by GCG Associates, Inc., Wilmington, Mass. The hearing is continued from May 3rd.

The applicant requested that the Board continue the hearing. The Board set a date for May 25 2005 at 8:00pm. The Board would review the definitive subdivision plan decision at this time.
