



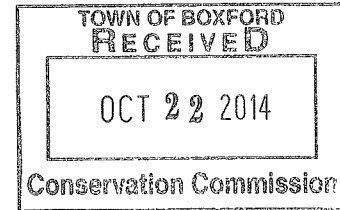

Dear Ross:

We have completed an as-built survey and plan for the above referenced site.

During construction, ledge was encountered which precluded the septic system from being installed as designed. A field change was engineered which utilized Infiltrator Chambers as a leach field, as opposed to conventional stone & pipe, the result was a leach field approximately 35% smaller.

No new design plan was prepared, the change was made based on a field change & sketch authorized by Kendell Longo from the BOH.

The new leach field is located entirely within the approved footprint of the approved design, the original footprint was 74 feet long by 15 feet wide and the revised footprint is 48 feet long by 14.2 feet wide, as such, the system was constructed to meet the setbacks and distances approved by the Commission and as shown on the attached As-Built Plan. Ledge was also encountered during the septic tank installation, the tank was relocated as shown, but again, located no closer to the wetland than the approved location.

Also enclosed is a completed WPA Form 8A, Request For Certificate of Compliance.

We hereby certify, that with exception to the aforementioned changes, the work was completed in compliance with the approved plan and order of Conditions and hereby request this matter be placed on your earliest meeting agenda for consideration of a Certificate of Compliance.

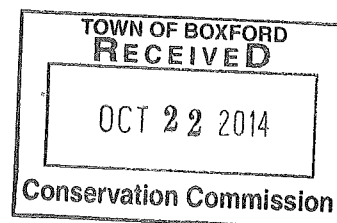
