Project Narrative #22 Trask Road, Boxford, MA 01921 September 28, 2015

Introduction:

The Applicants are proposing to install an in-ground swimming pool, patio, fence and pool house on their property at 22 Trask Road. The property is developed with a single family dwelling large yard and a horse paddock. The dwelling is surrounded by overlapping resource areas that extend onto the property. Most of the work, with the exception of some tree removal and the installation of the fence is proposed within existing maintained lawn and or landscaped areas. All of the work proposed, with the exception of the tree removal, complies with the minimum setback distance chart detailed in §375-98 B. (5).

Bordering Vegetated Wetlands:

There are Bordering Vegetated Wetlands, (BVW), to the right of the dwelling that are delineated as the A-Series as well as BVW to the rear of the dwelling that are delineated as the C-Series and in the front of the dwelling that are delineated as the D-Series. The A, C & D-Series are all hydrologically connected. The C-Series flows to the A-Series, partially through a 12-inch HPDE culvert and then daylights into a swale that is directly connected to the A-Series. The D-Series flows under the driveway, through a culvert, into the A-Series. The A & D-Series border on an intermittent stream.

Isolated Vegetated Wetlands:

There is a small isolated vegetated wetland in the rear of the horse paddock that is approximately 2,200 square feet. This wetland does not appear to be functioning as a vernal pool. This wetland was delineated as the B-Series and is below the 5,000 square foot threshold that would make it jurisdictional under the Town of Boxford Wetlands Protection Bylaw.

Summary:

As mentioned above, the project involves the construction of an in-ground swimming pool, patio, pool house and fence. In addition, the applicant is proposing to remove seven (7) large trees that are in close proximity to the existing dwelling. Two of the trees are located within the 25 Foot No Disturb Zone from the D-Series BVW.

Erosion controls are proposed during construction until the site is stabilized. The pool will be equipped with a non-backwash filtration system and there will be no backwash within jurisdictional areas. Access to the work area will be off the existing cul-de-sac and any stockpiles will be temporary in nature and on the up-slope side of the erosion controls.


