**Dear Commission Members:** 

In accordance with Condition 40 of the WPA Order of Conditions and Condition 10 of the Bylaw Order issued on May 8, 2006 find enclosed an As-Built Site Conditions plan for the above-referenced project. Also enclosed are the Form 8A – Request for Certificate of Compliance and post-construction photos.

I hereby certify that all work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and your Order with the following exceptions:

- The detached garage was rotated counter clockwise slightly. The majority of the northerly wall is now further from the wetlands than originally approved. The garage is 75 feet from the wetlands at its closest point as approved.
- The majority of the landscaping shown on the approved plans was not built. These areas are now either lawn or left alone to grow naturally.
- The proposed cobblestone curbing along the edge of the driveway was not constructed.
- The proposed 2 foot wide infiltration trench, which was to be covered with bark mulch, proposed along the edge of the driveway was not constructed. Water sheet flows off the driveway into grass strips along the edge of the driveway; there is no evidence that there is any erosion. The approved design proposed gaps every 25 feet in the proposed curb to allow runoff to discharge off the driveway. Because of the elimination of the curbing we no longer have multiple areas along the driveway resulting in concentrated flows; the as-built condition appears to be working fine.
- The proposed driveway circle was to be constructed of bricks or pavers; it is paved. There is no evidence of any adverse impacts to the wetland resource areas from this portion of the driveway being paved.
- The proposed stone entrance pillars at the beginning of the driveway were not constructed.

• The proposed shed located along the southerly edge of the driveway near the front of the property was not constructed. However a small paved parking area, approximately 550 sf in size, was constructed in the same vicinity as the proposed shed. There was a gravel parking area in this area before the latest construction started. With the removal of the shed the net increase in impervious area is approximately 450 sf. The paved parking area is 65 feet to the wetlands at its closest point; there does not appear to be any impacts to the wetland resource areas from the construction of this paved parking area.

The minor deviations listed above should not have any adverse impacts to the wetland resource areas. Therefore, at this time we are requesting that the Commission issue a Certificate of Compliance.
