**Step 6/Fee Payments:** To calculate the state share of the fee, divide the total fee in half and subtract \$12.50. To calculate the city/town share of the fee, divide the total fee in half and add \$12.50.

### 1.0 Project Location

The proposed project site is located at the corner of Deer Run Road and Willow Road within the Pine Ridge Subdivision and is located as shown in Figure 1 below.

#### 2.0 Project Description

Most of this lot was not part of the original 8-lot Pine Ridge subdivision (DEP #114-1151), but was acquired after approval of that subdivision. However, in planning for the subdivision it was anticipated that the additional land might be acquired. The stormwater management facility on the presently configured lot is being adjusted slightly to accommodate the new home and the slight increase in runoff.

Work within the 100-foot buffer zone includes construction of a new home a minimum of 75 feet from wetland resources, a well, stormwater management facilities, a portion of the driveway and site grading. All work is a minimum of 25 feet from wetland resources. The total area of buffer zone to be altered is 14,914 which is 6,318 square feet more than was proposed for the original subdivision filing. The proposed septic system is located entirely outside of the buffer zone.

A standard erosion control barrier consisting of silt sock will be installed between wetlands and all work areas as indicated on sheet C4 of the attached site plans. This will serve both as a limit of work and a means to prevent sediment from entering adjacent wetlands.
