

Project Narrative #41 Woodcrest Road, Boxford, MA 01921 (August 2, 2016)

Introduction:

The property is approximately 3.6 acres in size with frontage on Woodcrest Road and a large Bordering Vegetated Wetland, (BVW), in the rear. The lot is identified on the Town's Assessor's Map as Map 20, Block 9, Parcel 12 and is otherwise known as #41 Woodcrest Road. According to the Assessors field card the dwelling was constructed in 1962.

The lot was created in 1958 and is shown as Lot 13 on a plan entitled "Plan of Kelsey Highland, Boxford, Mass., March 24, 1958, Scale 1" = 40', Owner and Subdivider, Boxford Highlands, Inc., Raymond Pressey, Inc.", duly recorded with Essex South District Deeds, in Plan Book 90, Plan 87.

The applicants purchased the property on June 21, 2016 and engaged in activities within jurisdictional areas of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and Boxford Wetlands Protection Bylaw without proper permitting. More specifically, the work included the removal of vegetation and installation of fill material within 100 feet of Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

It is important to note that the applicants were not aware of the regulatory restrictions on the property and a lot of the thinning that was done within the no disturb zone was done by the previous owner. The applicant's intent was to grade the area to make the slope more uniform and to expand the lawn area, see attached photographs. The top photo shows the pre-activity condition and the photo below was taken by our office on July 18, 2016.

In addition to the work described above, the applicants are also proposing a swing set, $(10' \times 16')$ shed, and patio expansion within the 100 foot buffer zone.

Jurisdictional Resource Areas:

The wetland resource areas were delineated by Greg J. Hochmuth, PWS, CWS from Williams & Sparages, LLC on July 18, 2016. The following resource areas were identified:

Bordering Vegetated Wetlands, (BVW):

There is BVW in the rear of the existing dwelling. The BVW has been delineated as the A-Series using blue surveyors tape.

There is no work proposed with the BVW.

Performance Standards:

Section 375-98 B.(5) of Chapter 375: Wetlands Protection Regulations contains a minimum setback distance chart. According to the chart, structures that require a building permit are required to be 75 feet from the BVW, patios are required to be 30 feet and other alterations to naturally vegetated buffer zones are required to be 25 feet.

The proposed shed is 10'x 16'. According to the Zoning Bylaw a shed less than 200 square feet does not require a building permit. The shed is proposed within the 75 foot no build zone but outside of the 25 foot no disturb zone in an area that is existing maintained lawn. The shed should have no detrimental impact to the BVW.

The proposed patio expansion is well over the 30 foot setback and in an existing maintained lawn area. The proposal is to expand the existing patio to provide more seating area.

The swing set is proposed outside of the 25 foot no disturb zone and will not require a building permit. The swing set should have not detrimental impact to the BVW.

The fill material that was spread within the 25 foot no disturb area is proposed to be removed until the original forest surface is exposed. Once uncovered the area shall be scarified and seeded with a conservation seed mix. If required a thin layer of topsoil will be spread over areas that require material prior to the seeding effort. We expect the existing seed bank to take hold this fall and by next spring existing species to grow.

All areas where fill material was added shall be loamed and seeded with grass seed. Erosion controls shall remain in place until the surface is stable and permission is granted to remove them by the Conservation Commission and/or the Director of Conservation.

The existing overstory is intact so there was no need to conduct discretionary cutting area calculations.
