Dear Commission Members:

In accordance with Condition 40 of the MA Wetlands Protection Act Order of Conditions and Condition 12 of the Boxford Wetlands Protection Bylaw Order of Conditions, both issued on June 25, 2007, find enclosed an As-Built Site Conditions plan for the above-referenced project. Also enclosed is the Form 8A – Request for Certificate of Compliance as well as the \$50 fee.

I hereby certify that all work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and your Order of Conditions with the following exceptions:

- The driveway entrance at the street is larger than what was proposed/approved
- A portion of a culvert and stone rip-rap outfall were constructed within the 100 foot wetland buffer zone, these were not proposed on the approved plan.

The contractor expanded the size of the driveway entrance to make the access into the driveway a little easier. This change resulted in an increase in the driveway located within the 100 foot wetland buffer zone of approximately 120 square feet. The closest point from the driveway to the wetland is 85 feet. The driveway is constructed of re-processed asphalt and drains well; this change should have no impact on the resource area. Due to ledge, the site contractor was not able to grade the left side of the driveway as shown on the approved plan which results in a small portion of runoff being trapped. In order to drain this area, the contractor installed a 12" diameter ADS culvert under the driveway and constructed a stone outfall with the rocks he has on the site. The watershed flowing to this culvert is small and the runoff from this area was directed toward the wetland in the existing condition so this change will not impact the resource area.

At this time we ask that the Commission approve the deviations above and issue a Certificate of Compliance for the above referenced project.

We look forward to discussing this request with the Commission at your next regularly scheduled meeting.

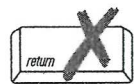
