D. Appeals

The applicant, owner, any person aggrieved by this Determination, any owner of land abutting the land upon which the proposed work is to be done, or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to request the appropriate Department of Environmental Protection Regional Office (see http://www.mass.gov/eea/agencies/massdep/about/contacts/) to issue a Superseding Determination of Applicability. The request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and Fee Transmittal Form (see Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form) as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Determination. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant if he/she is not the appellant. The request shall state clearly and concisely the objections to the Determination which is being appealed. To the extent that the Determination is based on a municipal ordinance or bylaw and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department of Environmental Protection has no appellate jurisdiction.

FINDINGS: The proposed project involves the construction of a trail within 100-feet of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. All work shall be performed so as to ensure that there will be no sedimentation into wetlands and surface waters during construction or after completion of the project.
- 2. The BCC and its Administrator, officers, and employees shall have the right to enter and inspect the property at any time for compliance with the conditions of this Determination, the Wetlands Protection Act MGL Chapter 131, Section 40, the Wetlands Regulations 310 CMR 10.00, Boxford Wetlands Protection Bylaw and Regulations and shall have the right to require any data or documentation that it deems necessary for that evaluation.
- 3. The BCC and its Administrator shall have the discretion to require erosion/siltation control prior to beginning work, and may require modifications to the erosion control during or after construction to ensure minimum impact on protected resources.
- 4. The BCC reserves the right to impose additional conditions on portions of this project or this site to mitigate any actual or potential impacts resulting from the work herein permitted.
- 5. All work shall be performed in accordance with this Determination of Applicability and approved site plan(s). No alteration of wetland resource areas or associated buffer zones, other than that approved in this Determination, shall occur on this property without prior approval from the BCC.
- 6. Any proposed changes in the approved plan(s) or any deviation in construction from the approved plan(s) shall require the applicant to file a Notice of Project Change with the BCC. The Notice shall be accompanied by a written inquiry as to whether the change is substantial enough to require filing a request to correct or amend this Determination.

PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION

7. Prior to the Pre-Activity Meeting and commencement of any activity on this site, the applicant shall notify the BCC in writing of the names, addresses and business and home telephone

numbers of the project supervisor and the contractor responsible for the work who shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with this Determination. Notification shall occur at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the Pre-Activity Meeting.

8. Prior to the commencement of any activity on this site, there shall be a **PRE-ACTIVITY MEETING** between the project supervisor, the contractor responsible for the work and a member of the Boxford Conservation Commission or its Administrator to ensure that the requirements of the Determination of Applicability are understood. Please contact the Boxford Conservation Commission office at (978) 887-6000, ext. 506 at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to any activity to arrange for the pre-activity meeting.

DURING CONSTRUCTION

9. Erosion and sedimentation control devices shall be inspected after each storm event and repaired or replaced as necessary. Any accumulated silt adjacent to the barriers shall be removed.

AFTER CONSTRUCTION

- 10. Upon completion of construction, the applicant or current landowner shall request in writing that the Boxford Conservation Commission and/or its Administrator conduct a final site inspection to verify that work has been completed in substantial compliance with this Determination and the approved site plan(s).
- 11. Erosion control devices shall remain in place and properly functioning until all exposed soils have been stabilized with final vegetative cover and the Boxford Conservation Commission and/or its Administrator has authorized their removal.
