

#### Introduction




Fig 1: USGS Topographic Quadrangle

The project site is an approximately 2.02 acre lot recently subdivided for construction of a new single family home to be accessed from Berry Patch Lane. The building site consists primarily of a mowed field formerly used to pasture horses. The project location is indicated in Figure 1 below.




Fig. 2: Project Locus

#### **Project Description**

The applicant proposes to construct a single family home and associated driveway and appurtenances, portions of which are located within the 100 foot buffer zone to wetland resources, including most of the stone driveway, paved parking area, the western portion of the house, a well and limited grading. The septic system is located entirely outside of the buffer zone. All work is proposed outside of the 25-foot No Disturb Zone and all structures are located outside of the No Construction Zone established under the Town of Boxford Wetlands Bylaw. The project requires only limited clearing of existing woody vegetation as most of the site is presently a mowed field.

A temporary erosion control barrier consisting of staked straw wattles is proposed between the limit of work and the wetland resource in order to delineate the construction boundary and to provide sedimentation protection during construction activities.

Upon completion of work all disturbed areas will be loamed and seeded to restore natural vegetative cover. Erosion controls will remain in place until vegetation is re-established and there is no further potential for sedimentation of the resource.

#### Wetland Resources

Wetland resources were delineated by James MacDougall of Biodiversity Consulting in December of 2016. The wetlands consist of a forested swamp located off-site to the west indicated as flags A1-A14 on the attached site plans. Wetlands contain an overstory of red maple (*Acer rubrum*) and understory of mixed shrubs including highbush blueberry (*Vaccinium corymbosum*) and northern arrow-wood (*Viburnum recognitum*). A narrow man-made drainage swale that appears to have been constructed to direct flow toward this wetland was delineated by flags B1-B9.
