Dear Commission Members:

Based on our discussions with Jon Graham it is our understanding that the Commission has requested that he have an engineer or surveyor measure/certify the distances from the deck that are attached to the addition and the detached garage to the existing stream. On Thursday, February 15, 2018, I visited the site and measured the closest points from the deck and the detached garage to the edge of the stream with the following results:

- Distance from deck adjacent to addition to the stream = 37'
- Distance from detached garage to stream = 48'

The attached sketch shows where the distances were taken.





 - (a) The size, shape, type and location of the proposed work.

Addition to existing home within Buffer Zone. Two story wood frame on 432 sq. feet of existing lawm area. The shape will be rectangular 18' X 24' as depicted on attached site plan.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the Notice of Internal and the accompanying plans.

No alteration of the terrain including but not limited to tree cutting or regrading, shall be done in the buffer zone between the wetland and the haybale siltation barrier as located on the plan.

All staked haybales shall be maintained at a distance of at least 15° from any excavation or stockpiled material within the buffer zone.

No material stockpiled within the buffer zone shall have a slope greater than 2:1.

Any stockpiled material stored in the buffer zone for more than one month shall be stabilized with temporary seed cover or other stabilization measures approved by the Conservation Commission.

All regraded slopes shall be seeded in accordance with the standards set in Appendix 2 of the Erosion and Sedimentation Guidlines, August 1983, prepared by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts DEQE, except that no fertilizer shall be applied within the buffer zone.

The Conservation Commission shall be provided with the names and addresses of all contractors prior to the commencement of work and an estimated work schedule.

Non-operating vehicles, equipment, petroleum oils and lubricants and hazardous materials shall not be stored in the wetland or the buffer zone.

A copy of this Order and the reference plan shall be kept on-site at all times and all contractors informed of the conditions therein.

The Boxford Conservation Commission and the DEQE have the right to enter and inspect the premises to determine compliance with this Order. Should violations be observed, all work shall cease until such time that measures are taken to correct said violations.

Approval of this application does not constitute compliance with any other law or regulation other than MGLA Chapter 131, Sec. 40 and the Boxford Wetlands Protection Bylaw.

Any revisions to the project described in the Notice of Intent and accompanying plans will require a resubmission to the Conservation Commission.
