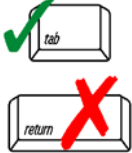

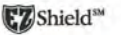

Project Narrative

The Applicant, Rodney Smith submits this Notice of Intent for the extension of an existing driveway located at 427C Ipswich Road in Boxford, Massachusetts.

Presently, the access to 427C Ipswich Road is through a common driveway shared with 427B Ipswich Road. The proposed work involves the continuation from the existing common driveway to Ipswich Road. A section of the common driveway will be removed and revegetated with herbaceous cover. The proposed driveway extension will have gravel shoulders to infiltrate runoff. Minor grading will be required for the driveway construction. The majority of the grading is outside of the 100' Buffer Zone.

In total, the proposed work will cause for a decrease in impervious surfaces within the 100' Buffer Zone by 20± S.F (1,125 S.F. vs 1,105 S.F.).

As proposed, eight trees will be removed for the driveway with only one tree being within the 100' Buffer Zone. The Applicant proposes to plant native shrubs and trees along the driveway.

There are Bordering Vegetated Wetlands to the north of the area of work. Erosion control will be installed prior to the start of work and will act as the limit of work and will be maintained by the contractor.

The site is not located within any mapped Priority Habitat or Estimated Habitat polygons. There are no Certified or Potential Vernal Pools located within or in proximity to the site. The site is not located within a FEMA Flood Zone.
