NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
REMOVAL OF PUBLIC SHADE TREE & SCENIC ROADS ACT

The Boxford Planning Board and the Tree Warden will hold a Public Hearing pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 87, Sections 3 & 4 (Removal of Public Shade Trees) & Chapter 40, Section 15C (Scenic Roads Act) to consider the removal of the following trees:

1. 112 Ipswich – two 24” oaks dying and and splitting at the V shaped base of the tree
2. Ipswich between Carolina Way and Georgetown Road – three dead pines, 12”, 24” 36”
3. Intersection of Mill and Middleton – eight trees various sizes from 4” to 12” are leaning into the intersection or are dying
4. 76 Mill – 24” severely leaning red oak
5. 68 Mill – 24” oak at edge of asphalt with plow marks
6. 67 Mill – 30” pine diseased with ants, 18” oak edge of asphalt
7. 61 Mill – 24” oak edge of asphalt
8. 49 Mill – 36” oak dying and close to edge
9. 47 Mill - 18” oak edge and hit by plows, 24” oak edge and dying
10. 40 Mill – 36” oak dead, 48” oak dead, 6” maple dead
11. 33 Mill – 48” oak edge and plow damage
12. 17 Mill – 18” oak edge and plow damage
13. Mill and Main – 24” oak very diseased
14. 404 Main St – 18” oak is severely leaning over road
15. 22 Rowley – 5 oaks along edge
16. 32 Rowley – 6 oaks along edge
