He felt that there were three areas of interest; the driveway crossing, the possible vernal pool and the site clearing. S. Trinkaus presented an alternative to the original driveway to include a 20' squash pipe for the crossing with a vegetative swale for the runoff. V. Nelson was concerned about the ledge cuts, grading and blasting for the driveway and suggested some alternatives. G. Bollard asked that trees of interest be marked and there be some protection of the trees he felt that there was more work being proposed than will be necessary. C. Read was concerned about the salt runoff as well. S. Trinkaus said that the driveway would pitch away from the vernal pool. There was a short discussion about an alternative site for the house. There was also discussion about the work being done in dry conditions and temporary seeding being done. S. Purdy asked about the length of the driveway which is 1700 feet. G. Bollard asked that the utility run be shown on the plan and the stockpile areas should have the size noted on the plan. The applicant will return next month with changes.
