Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Chairman Frank Sproviero. The meeting was being recorded.

Minutes of the regular meeting held May 15, 2012.

The following corrections were made to the minutes:

1. Under Miscia the language was changed to say: He also suggested alternatives for diverting the water that did not require mechanical pumps.
2. Under O'Dell, 436 Main Street South, oil spill. Remediation replaced clean up

G. Bollard made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on May 15, 2012 as corrected.

C. Read seconded. C. Read, S. Purdy, G. Bollard, V. Nelson, F. Sproviero were in favor. D. Fitch abstained as not present at the last meeting.

Comments from the Public: none

Old Business:

1. Miscia, 300 Rocky Hill Road, boat house. The applicant was granted a 65 day extension.

New Business:

1. Shabet, 98 Benson Road, dam repair and pond work. Withdrawn without prejudice.
2. Shabet, 45 Iron Ore Hill Road, bridge repair. Withdrawn without prejudice.
3. Kwon/Kang, 209 Henry Sanford Road, driveway repairs. Tom Seger presented this application to the commission. A four foot pipe is being proposed. G. Bollard asked how long the project will take. T. Seger felt it would take a couple of days. V. Nelson asked for more details on the sump and the pump. It was suggested to wait for a time when the stream was dry. G. Bollard asked for an elevation for the driveway. V. Nelson and D. Fitch will meet T. Seger and Brian Neff on the property.
4. Sunny Valley, LLC. 98 Benson Road, dock. Rob Shaver presented the application to the commission. The applicant wants to install a dock and put in a foot path down to the dock. G. Bollard asked for the reparation rights to the dock to pass and repass over CL&P properties. R. Shaver will look into that. The applicant wants to clear logs and vegetation along the path. There is one spot that will need a bridge. G. Bollard asked about the trees that are marked. Those are the trees that will be staying. No material will be used on the path. There will be no utilities. D. Fitch asked how long the foot path will be. The estimate is 2500 feet. F. Sproviero, G. Bollard and D. Fitch will be the case officers. F. Sproviero will be the lead.
5. Nature Conservancy – Sunny Valley Preserve, Hut Hill Road, restore and repair trails. Wayne Woodard presented the application to the commission. He is proposing to restore a section of the trail that was destroyed by storms last fall. He is proposing to place woodchips and water bars along the trail. C. Read and S. Purdy will look at the trails. The feeling was that this project is a right of maintenance.

Enforcement:

R. Dirienzo's report was received by the commission.

F. Sproviero received a complaint about trees being cut on Old Town Highway. He will contact R. Dirienzo.

1. O'Dell, 436 Main Street South, oil spill. F. Sproviero said the he was waiting for feedback.
