- J Moker- discussed parking lot across from Senior Ctr with C Read. He is okay with it but needs more info. E Sootbeer will follow up on this.
- R Allen- to get quotes on lining 1 tennis court and a net for pickleball tabled to February
- J Moker-spoke with Leslie, Rec Director in Kent regarding their ACE program. It is run as a babysitting program with some activities. Have 9-16 students/day. Cost is \$11 for 2.5hrs
- J Moker- spoke with C Read about painting Kitchen & bathrooms at the Pavilion. He has approved. Sill need confirmation of where funds are coming from for the updates. Get price from J Sincerbeaux to make replacement grills.

**NEW BUSINESS:**


