7:50 PM Public Inquiry: Brian Caron – Palmer Road Forrest Cutting Plan

Brian Caron attended tonight meeting to express his concerns with the Commissions comments regarding his proposed Forest Cutting Plan that DCR denied. The commission had issues with the wetlands delineations on the plan, the location of the proposed landing in regards to the BVW on site, and the altering of the access piece through logging work. Mr. Caron presented the FCP to the commission, stated he is having the plan re-prepared by a certified forester and explained how the proposed work would not affect the parcel 11 A9, with the administrative order on it. The administrator instructed Caron to re-submit the FCP and have the forester write a letter certifying the work/logging conducted on the back parcel (11 A10), would not affect or alter the land on the access parcel (11 A9) with the order on it. If the proposed logging does not violate the order, there is no reason for it to be denied considering it is being proposed on a separate parcel.

BCC received a complaint from 60 Haynes Hill Rd about a recently installed drainage pipe that is pointed directly at their house.

Both Panaccione and deBruyn conducted site visits and came to the same conclusion that though it is poorly positioned, there is an accompanying vegetative drainage swale that conveys the water directly to Haynes Hill Rd. The site visits were conducted on rainy days, when the pipe was flowing steadily and no noticeable flooding occurred on the neighboring property. Panaccione took picture of the pipe and supplied them to the commission for review. The commission determined there was no violation present.
