OLD BUSINESS: FILM FESTIVAL. The Board viewed the shorts selection from Sundance and agreed that most of the shorts were disturbing and violent. The only ones considered might be either Irish Folk Furniture, Catnip or What Do We Have In Our Pockets?. Mary contacted Lincoln Center and Tribeca Film Festival. Tribeca suggested viewing two films - Procession with Lilly Tomlin and Picture Paris with Julia Louis-Dreyfus. Mary brought to the meeting discs from previous BAC Film Festivals and some discs that we did consider at one time, but did not use. These could be considered for this year's festival. Ray had suggested that we use "Goodbye to the Normals", a cute short about a little British boy running away from home to America. Mary will also try to get "La Luna" from Pixar Films. VENUE: Edmond Town Hall. Chris Aher joined our meeting and he is going to work with Ray in setting up for the Festival. We are still looking for a screen and we could use the Town's projector or rent one. Ann is going to ask her daughter about the projector she has and if it is suitable, we could use it and save a rental fee of \$800.00. JC Barone will edit films. We discussed catering options for the Festival...we could use Alex Hunter or Eileen Cabral. Eileen is an event planner at Ethan Allen and has great suggestions, such as a Harvest Table. The Board decided on a ticket price of \$15.00. We are not going to have an auction this time and we will possibly have a raffle and tshirts.

Hanna B will talk to Mr. Palumbo about having a 90 minute program of short films created by BHS students. Ray brought the fliers to the meeting for the Workshop and asked that we each take some of them to distribute around town.
