

BROOKFIELD BOARD OF FINANCE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8, 2015 7:00pm BROOKFIELD TOWN HALL, ROOM 209

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Chairman P. Kurtz called the meeting to order at 7:00pm; beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by S. O'Reilly, seconded by J. Rossi, to move New Business, "Budget", ahead of Approval of Minutes. Secretary R. Gianazza amended the motion to discuss 2015-2016 Town Budget Agenda Item first. All were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Chairman P. Kurtz, seconded by S. O'Reilly, to add \$150,000 back to cash to capital roads. The bond capital will be left as is and to fund the \$150,000 back to cash to capital out of the Public Dept Item 174, Line Item 5801 Bond Principle. Motion passed 6-0.

A motion was made by Vice Chairman E. Nepomuceno, seconded by S. O'Reilly, to accept all changes relative to cash to capital and short term financing and that ¼ of the short term financing will be put into the cash to capital line item. Motion passed 6-0.

A motion was made by Dr. R. Appleby, seconded by S. O'Reilly, to increase the CLA budget by \$10,000 to \$84,636 and to fund it by reducing cash to capital. Motion passed 5-1.
