- 3. <u>Discuss the hire of a firm to conduct an investigation of general fund discrepancies</u> Chairman R. Gianazza stated that he has been in contact with Patrick Malloy, Yale University. Mr. Malloy's specialty is Forensic Investigations. Mr. Malloy suggested using grad students to help with the grunt work. Chairman R. Gianazza will report to the Board next month.

- 4. <u>Discuss requested legal fees</u> Chairman R. Gianazza stated that the Board of Finance does not accept bills from outside parties or pay bills.
- 5. <u>Evaluate current status of discretionary accounts</u> Town Controller, K. Siegrist, stated that this account has been depleted.
