1. <u>**RG49 Federal Road Property**</u> – A motion was made by M. Mulvaney, seconded by Vice Chairman J. Rossi, that the Board of Finance approve the Board of Selectmen's request in an amount of \$244,500 out of the contingency fund (Line #01202) for payment to the State of Connecticut for the value of property at 49 Federal Road and for the lifting of the deed restrictions. Motion passes 6-0.
