She recognized the following people for their outstanding leadership to the camp programs: Amanda Eide, Director; Emily Bonomo, Head Counselor; Camp Pee Wee and ,Camp Summer Better Than Others; Ashley Prizio – Camp Voyager, and Gail Jaffe – Camp Cadigan. She also had a fantastic group of camp counselors this summer. The Town Park Beach has been running smoothly under direction of Kristen Faucher, Waterfront Director; and Mark Grossman, Assistant Director, since May 25. Also an excellent staff at the waterfront. The Brookfield Muskrats Swim Team season ended on August 4 and swimming lessons are ending this week. The Etrak software they have been using to verify pass holders this season has been very successful, and will continue the practice in the future. The USTA Tennis season closed at the end of July. Five teams were fielded for competition this summer: 8 and under, 10 and under, 12 and under, 14 and under, and 18 and under. Each team participated in 6 matches, 3 home and 3 away, as well as weekly practices.
