7. <u>Informal Discussion:</u>

1. Peter Young – Lot Approval Whispering Glen: *Present was Mr. P. Young as an agent for Mr. B. Fishman f Finmarc Custom Homes, LLC.* Mr. Young presented a copy of the original approved site plan for this subdivision, noting the history of the property whose previous owner did not complete the entire subdivision. Finmarc Custom Homes is the present owner, and Mr. Young was seeking input from the Commission on how to file applications to complete the six remaining lots, one of which has a home on it. A set of documents from Mr. Young showed that there were certificates of foreclosure for lots 5, 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12, and that the taxes for each were paid and up to date, with the transfer of each to Finmarc Custom Homes.

Per a review of the plan, which highlighted the aforementioned lots, the Commission determined that, given the contiguous location of two groups, that two separate subdivision applications may be submitted: one for lots 5, 6, and 7, and one for lots 9, 11 and 12. Mr. Young will work with Ralph on the bonding estimate.
