3. Department Update:

- a. Major Purcell reported on two grants recently funded to the Department:
 - 1. E-Ticketing Grant: a joint grant with New Milford for software installed in police vehicles. Installation will be completed this week.
 - 2. Rural Road Speed Enforcement Grant: Sergeant Frengs applied for and received this Federal grant for equipment and staff overtime which will enable the Department to target problematic and high complaint areas, as well as school zones.
- b. Major Purcell informed the Commissioners of potential vacancies pending the contract renewal at the end of June, 2015. The Department is proactively preparing by enrolling on PoliceApp.com which will administer written tests for potential candidates.
- c. As of September 3, 2014, the Brookfield Police Department has become the first Department in the state to submit reports electronically using the Crash Reporting System.

- d. Major Purcell outlined a study being conducted by the State Department of Transportation. This study is concentrating on traffic, pedestrian and construction concerns of lower Route 202. He will keep the Commission updated.
