	The WPCA accountant is a separate person from the town's accountant and the WPCA
	accountant turns over her work papers to the town's accountant for purposes of the unified
	audit
	The WPCA charges at a rate to cover expenses, but does not include depreciation in this calculation ¹
	The chairman desires that the WPCA have enough reserve to replace capital equipment
	Each town sewer district has its own benefits assessment calculation
