1. Meeting called to order at 6 PM

2. As a public comment Richard Zacher presented a copy of a proposed warrant article that had been presented to the town selectmen at their 11/27/2012 meeting. The article is in regards to a zoning change on a Kingswood Lake property.

5. Old Business: Tom Giguere reported a letter has been sent to NH Electric Co-op concerning the town scenic roads.

The concern about debris being dumped in the Smith Gravel Pit was discussed and will be brought up at the next selectmen meeting.

There has been a grant application presented to the Rails to Trails Committee.

A budget request for 2013 for the Conservation Committee for \$500 has been presented to the Selectmen.

Commission input has been submitted for the town newsletter by Tom Giguere.

6. New Business: Commission minutes are up to date on the town website.

The town annual report is due soon. Anyone with interesting pictures is encouraged to submit them.

Richard Peckham gave an excellent summary of the Lakes Region Conservation Plan meeting that was presented at Moose Mountain Lodge on 11/8/2012.
