B. Town Clean-up and Selectmen's Breakfast April 27th. The breakfast along with town cleanup is on schedule for the 27th of April. Tom G. will ask moderator Dr. Marsh to announce the particulars of the breakfast at the town meeting.

C. NH Association of Conservation Commissions dues. The Commission is aware of the rising town tax rate and felt the \$185 for dues was not warranted as we have not used the association in years. As discussed last meeting, Tom G. called the Association asking if we qualified for a less expensive membership category. Unfortunately, there is no other option, but the NHACC will still offer help even if we aren't a member. Dick made a motion to not pay the dues, John seconded and the motion passed.

6. New Business:

A. The State of NH puts out a series of maps for recreational purposes. A suggestion was put forth about having the trails in the Brookfield area put into these maps. Further discussion indicated that there was not a place on the maps to include such information.

B. Dulcie reported that the MMRG Annual Meeting held on February 4th at the Wolfeboro Inn was well attended and very informative.
