Tom Giguere reported that a conservation easement has been completed on the 37 acre Nute property in Milton.
- 7. Selectman's representative Bill Nelson questioned the commission about \$500 warrant article to be placed in the upcoming town budget. The commission requested that the warrant be included by the Selectmen to help build up the Conservation Fund.
- 8. Richard Peckham reported that the planning board is holding a meeting on January 13, 2014 to discuss redefining zoning changes in the Moose Mountain Recreation Zone. The public is urged to attend.
- 9. Due to a lack of attendees available for the February 5, 2014 meeting, it was decided to cancel it.
