

HERITAGE COMMISSION MEETING

Wednesday, 10 July 2013

Present: Marilou MacLean; Harriet Wilson; Dave Proctor; Patricia Golden; Susan Raban; Brian Robischeau; and Rich Zacher, selectman.

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 pm by Marilou MacLean. Patricia moved to accept the minutes of June 12; Dave seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

This meeting was devoted almost entirely to Old Home Day planning. Marilou has suggested that we hold a genealogy workshop on a Saturday in November, giving folks and opportunity to review Town Records at that time, rather than do one on Old Home Day. All agreed. We will ask the Strafford County Genealogy Society to put on the workshop.

For Old Home Day, we will ask folks who attended the Churchill School to come to the Town House and tell their stories, which will be recorded. Both buildings will be open, with displays. We hope to have a display on the needed repairs to the Schoolhouse, showing the plans for doing those repairs in stages over the next two or three years. There will also be a display on TRAC, with a sweatshirt raffle to benefit TRAC.

All available will meet at the Schoolhouse on August 4 at 2:00 pm to clean up the Schoolhouse and put it in order. Then at 10:30 am on August 10, we will meet at the Town House to set up the displays. We will switch off being at the Town House for the day. Dinner set up will begin at 4:00 pm; waitpeople are to come at 4:30 pm. The dinner will be from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Tickets will be \$12.00 each, with children's tickets at \$6.00. We are hoping Rose Zacher will be able to be the ticket person.

Food assignments are as follows:

Dave:	1 pot of beans; 1 pan of cornbread
Harriet:	2 pans of cornbread; cookies; & brownies
Susan:	6 pans of cornbread
Patricia:	1 pan of cornbread; 1 blueberry cake; 1 pot of beans
Marilou:	1 pot of beans; 1 cornbread; blueberry cake; cookies
Brian:	1 pot of beans

Harriet will ask Art Wheeler for a pot of beans as well. She will also do the TRAC display & poster for the raffle. We will continue to check sources for tablecloths or tablecloth fabric as we had to discard several tablecloths last year.

Marilou reported that the person who did the work on the Milton Town House will tour our buildings with the Planning Board, the Heritage Commission, and the Selectmen. Rich will let us know when that will be.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be Wednesday, August 7, at 7:00 pm. There will be a meeting on July 18 among the Selectmen, 2 members of the Planning Board, and Marilou & Harriet from the Heritage Commission to finalize the Selectmen's letter & questionnaire to the Townspeople about the Schoolhouse.
