Agenda Item – Discuss Changes to Rules and Regulations for the Operations and Maintenance of Wastewater Treatment Facilities

Discussion – Mr. Martin noted that the Commission has yet to receive a comment back on their 2006 submission to DEM. Mr. Kane suggested that the Commission use the 2006 submission as the basis for the new submission.

Mr. Kane suggested that with the new Rules and Regulations, the Commission should increase their penalties and notify those who it will affect.

There was some discussion on privately owned pump stations. Mr. Kane suggested that the private developments provide the Commission with a plan on how they would address a failure of their system. Mr. Wolfe noted that it is very important that the Commission gets the right to go onto private property to fix a problem. There was also some discussion on offer maintenance agreements to private developments.

The Commission will set a date at their July meeting, to have Mr. Geremia to come back to with an outline of all of the tasks that need to be addressed.

Being no further business to come before the Commission, Mr. Wolfe closed the Workshop.
