Minutes of 16 May, 11 approved as corrected.

- 1) Green-Up Day bill – Ralph’s 72. 05. Motion passed to pay bill.
- 2) Adopt-a-Highway Program renewal – CCC voted to renew for two-years
- 3) Arm funding project – end of Morningside Lane – New Hampshire Natural Heritage bureau has no record of any endangered species in the area. Jan Lambert still researching.
- 4) Nature Trail – Steve Dumont met with Doug Graham, DOT, and walked the proposed changes. Mr. Graham thinks it is a worthy project and advises CCC to send a letter to the DOT Commissioner asking permission to use state right-of-way. Lew Shelley of SCA will write a letter with construction details to enclose in the package.
