The Selectboard meet with Ms. Eastley to discuss the ongoing issues she is having with her neighbor. Ms. Eastley states that her neighbor is harassing/stalking her and poisoning her animals. Ms. Eastley feels the Charlestown Police Department has not taken her situation seriously; due to their inability/unwillingness to assist her she has contacted several other agencies who are unable to assist her either. Chief Connors explained that the Charlestown Police Department has done an investigation and found Ms. Eastley complaints about her neighbor unfounded and are they are unable to find evidence about her allegations.

Chief Connors was asked to leave so the Selectboard could continue their meeting with Ms. Eastley. The Board explained that they are unable to assist Ms. Eastley if she is unable to provide them with proper documents from her veterinarian or other evidence. Ms. Eastley has been asked to provide documentation to the Selectboard so they can investigate her allegations through their own means.

Ambulance Abatement: Ms. Dennis received an ambulance abatement request from a resident in the amount of \$571.00 for financial hardship. The request was tabled. There have been two people who are deceased that have remaining balances. Their insurance has been billed and payments have been received. The Selectboard agreed to abate the balances on these two individuals.

Steve moved to exit non public session, second by Mr. St. Pierre. All in favor.
