The Town has requested input from the HDC (Historic District Commission) regarding a new name for the old town hall. It was agreed that we felt the building should be renamed "The Charlton Community Center".

Julia will obtain a digital copy of the walking tour from Nick, the graphics designer.

The ZORC (Zoning Ordinance Review Commission) meetings are likely to continue for another 10 months. This was expected to be a short term commitment which has evolved into a long term effort by the HDC Chairman. The reason offered for the present need for a time extension is to merge the Charlton Farmland Plan and the Charlton Comprehensive Plan into the ZORC.

Julia needs another copy of the electronic version of the Charlton Historic District Ordinance (Charlton Local Law #2).

A "Get Well Soon" note for Fuji was created by Laura Linder and signed by the HDC members.

On Wednesday February 3, 2010 Historian/Author Teri Gay will present a program called "Strength without Compromise" at the Town Hall.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday March 17 (rescheduled to Tuesday March 23, 2010), at 7:00pm (the third Wednesday of the month). The meeting adjourned at 8:00pm.
