April 23, 2018

The Agenda Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Charlton, Saratoga County, New York was held at the Charlton Town Hall, 758 Charlton Rd, Charlton, NY and called to order by Supervisor Grattidge at 7:30 p.m. to set the agenda for the May 14th meeting.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Town's spring brush pick-up is in process this week, April 23rd to April 27th.

COMMUNICATIONS

The Sales Tax report was not received yet this month and the Mortgage Tax was \$15,702.00.

The CHIPS money from the State for the Highway budget this year will be \$109,194.00. The State has also informed the Town that our share of the PAVE NY program this year will be \$24,921.42, and the Extreme Winter Recovery amount will be \$20,409.74. The total that the Town Highway Department will receive from the State this year is \$154,515.56. The Board will do a budget amendment at the next meeting to add the money to the 2018 budget. Discussion ensued regarding this, and Supervisor Grattidge said that he feels that the way that the Town currently handles budgeting just the CHIPS money each fall for the next year's budget is the best way to go, since the Town is not ensured that they will receive the extra program funds each year. Superintendent Heritage said that he heard that PAVE NY and the Extreme Winter funding will not be available next year.

Supervisor Grattidge said that in 1996 a Highway Reserve Fund was established by resolution, to be used to save money for equipment. There is currently a balance of about \$16,000 and the Highway Superintendent would like to use that money for the equipment that the Board will vote to accept the bids on tonight. Attorney

Van Vranken said that withdrawal of the funds is subject to a permissive referendum. The Board plans to hold the public hearing on May 29th. The Town also plans to receive Hurricane Stella reimbursement from the State, and that money will be used to pay for the equipment. The Highway Superintendent has placed old equipment for sale on GovDeals.com and will also use the proceeds towards the cost of the newly acquired equipment.

Supervisor Grattidge said that the County has made an agreement with Inside Rx to provide discounted pharmacy benefits to uninsured and underinsured county residents. Information kits will be available at the Town Clerk's office beginning in May.

DISCUSSION

Councilman Ranaletto said that he and fellow Board members have interviewed several people interested in filling the Town Board vacancy created by the resignation of Councilman Hodgkins at the end of April. He said that he would like to nominate Dave Robbins for the position. The Board had no objection. A resolution is planned for the next meeting to appoint Mr. Robbins to begin on May 15th.

Councilman Hodgkins said that the next meeting of the Party in the Park Committee is on May 8th at 6:30pm.

Councilman Ranaletto said that the Building and Zoning office has been working with their new operations software and hope to go live with it next week.

Councilwoman Heritage said that she has started connecting with each Department that she is liaison to. She has met with the Parks Committee and they are continuing their 2018 projects as well as working with BHBL Junior Baseball to improve the baseball field in Elmer Smith Park. The Highway Superintendent, community volunteers and parents from the league have been working on the field.

Supervisor Grattidge said that the Board will continue to discuss whether or not the Town Board should expand their use of social media. Councilwoman Heritage has been the volunteer administrator of Friends of Charlton NY Facebook page for many years. The page was particularly effective this past weekend in engaging the community regarding a lost dog.

Councilman Grasso said that the Planning Board met last week and reviewed a lot line adjustment on Charlton Road and made a recommendation on a ground mounted solar project. The Planning Board wants to make minor changes and updates to the Subdivision Regulations as well as the Design and Construction Standards, both of which have not been updated in a long time. The Councilman informed the Planning Board that if they came up with a list of changes to the 2 documents, he will bring it to the Town Board for discussion. Supervisor Grattidge has spoken with the Zoning Administrator who is making a list of minor changes that he would like to have made to the Zoning Ordinance.

Councilman Grasso said that he and Councilman Hodgkins first ran for the Town Board seats in 2013 and have worked together on the Board since 2014. Councilman Hodgkins has taught him a lot about infrastructure and shared his knowledge of equipment which has been very helpful to the Town. He thanked Councilman Hodgkins for his years of service to the Town and expressed how nice it was to work with him. Supervisor Grattidge reminded everyone how instrumental Councilman Hodgkins was in helping to reconstruct the footbridge in Elmer Smith Park. Through his connections, the Councilman secured a really great quality bridge for a really reduced cost.

Supervisor Grattidge said that he and Highway Superintendent Heritage met with Spectrum and they confirmed that they are laying cable on Upper Cook Road and Upper Northline Road.

Supervisor Grattidge said that he received a call from a resident concerned about safety as recently there were 17 cars parked in the road for AIM Services on Vines Road. The Constables said that they were aware that there was a funeral service there recently which may have been the same day. They will continue to monitor the area.
