#### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

#### **COMMUNICATIONS**

Supervisor Grattidge said that during the closure of Route 67, a device that records traffic and speed was placed on Charlton Road. From October 5<sup>th</sup> to October 18<sup>th</sup>, 60,518 vehicles were recorded on Charlton Road with an average speed of 32.33 mph, and the highest recorded speed of 61 mph.

#### **DEPARTMENT & COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Highway – The following work was reported for October: Chipped brush town wide (Oct.25 to Oct.29), Unplug culverts were we have beaver problems, Patch pot holes, Trim trees and brush around signs, Working on sanders, Painting Sanders, Working on trucks getting ready for winter, Hauled ice control sand, NYSI done on truck's # 12.

Planning – The Board met on October 18<sup>th</sup> for a Public Hearing and deliberated on 3 subdivision applications. On November 13<sup>th</sup>, the Board will do a site visit on the lands of William Grabo.

Water – John Morgan has reported having a problem with a valve in the booster pump.

Constables – They had 31 patrols, handled 27 complaints, 5 911 calls, 2 accident, and issued 56 tickets.

Communications Committee – The Committee is working on their final presentation and recommendation to the Town Board.

### **PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR**

Terry Ostrander, Western Avenue asked if he could get a copy of the Town Budget. He also stated that he heard a rumor that the lawsuit against the Town by the contractor for the Town Hall has been settled out of court, and that the Town lost. He asked the Board if that was correct. Attorney Van Vranken responded for the Board and stated that this rumor is absolutely not true. The case is still in the discovery stage and has not gone to court yet. With the current timeline, there are hopes that the case may be settled by the end of 2011. The case will be heard in Supreme Court.

Eva Butler said that the Community Center is in need of a "Community Center" sign. Councilman Verola said that she will check with the Highway Superintendent for a status.

Marv Schorr said that George Hobson, the Environmental Planning Supervisor for the County has retired after many years of service.

The meeting adjourned at 8:07 p.m.
