I'm working toward an island-wide shell recycling program. Other states have successful programs and I think one on MV is overdue. Ideally we'd be keeping shell out of landfills and have it on hand for planting oyster reefs wherever constables feel the need. The program would target local business and residents and include on-site pickup with provided bins.

Do you have any ideas for an up-island location for a large amount of shell storage?

Obviously there are impromptu middens all over the island. I'm thinking up-island could benefit from a more 'lockdown' location so shell can be quarantined, conditioned, and saved for oyster restoration projects, rather than be scooped up and used for landscape/driveways.
