The Martha's Vineyard Commission (MVC), is pleased to submit the Martha's Vineyard Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) 2011 Update, FFY 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and FFY 2012 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).


The objective of the Regional Transportation Plan is to establish the framework and guidelines for decision-makers to use when selecting among projects, programs, and facilities that have different and sometimes conflicting objectives. These must have a twenty-year planning horizon. The Regional Transportation Plan recommends studies and specific short-term and long-term project priorities that are needed to maintain the existing transportation infrastructure and produce a more balanced, safe and affordable regional transportation system.

The TIP serves as a prioritized listing of roadway, bridge, and transit projects proposed for implementation during the next several federal fiscal years (FFY 2012-2015).

The UPWP describes and provides budgetary information for the transportation planning tasks and activities, which are to be conducted in the region during the coming year.
