SUBJECT: Recommendation: Three Tea Lane Farm Finalists

This recommends three candidates for your final interviews and the eventual selection of the Tea Lane Farmer.

Background

The Tea Lane Farm Committee includes Warren Doty, Brian Cioffi, Dick Smith, Mitchell Posin and Billy Meegan.

The Committee reviewed 13 separate, detailed plans that included a farm plan, a plan to renovate and use the historic farmhouse, a plan for the other outbuildings and a financial schedule for investment in the plans with anticipated operating revenue and expenses.

The Committee selected 6 semi-finalists and interviewed each candidate for at least 45 minutes—see enclosed interview questions. It deliberated for two evenings after conducting the interviews and recommends the following three finalists in rank order of preference. Each of their plans is enclosed for your review.

- 1. Allen Healy.
- 2. Krishana Collins.
- 3. Rusty Gordon and Sarah Crittenden.

These selections and final rankings reflect the overall strengths of each candidate's farm plan, their renovation plans for the historic farmhouse, their financial resources and investment plan and their knowledge and experience needed to succeed.
