#### 1. Outside Funding:

- Cape Cod Towns already received \$500,000 from the State to implement the program
- Cape Cod Commission will apply for additional \$200,000 to continue and expand the project
- Cape Cod Economic Development Council in also helping with the funding

- 2. <u>Maintain Town Identity, Forms, Rules & Rates:</u>
  - Customized solutions by town
  - Dollars obtained from the solution are deposited directly into the individual town's accounts
  - Security & other administration can be done by each town

#### 3. Customer Service Improvements:

- 24x7 Customer Access to Services
- Transparency
- Additional Payment Options
- Elimination of Redundant Handwriting / Typing
- Automated Department Coordination
- Eliminate Trips to Town Buildings
- A Similar Process Across Multiple Towns
- One system for most Permits, License and Inspections

#### 4. Operating Cost Containment:

- Efficiency: Online system eliminates keying, scanning
  & filing
- System integration: Regional process improvement ideas and resources will integrate existing applications further reducing redundant work
- Automated: E-Mail Renewal Notifications
- Mobile Inspection Workforce (if desired)

#### 5. Technical Infrastructure Cost Sharing:

- Pricing: Server licensing cost for single town same as the region
- Hardware: Vendor Cloud, State Spring Data Center, or OpenCape Servers, Disaster Recovery

- 6. Shared Implementation Cost & Knowledge:
  - The regions towns shares many of the same Financial Mgmt, Assessing, GIS & other systems - interfaces required for the solution that can be designed once to these common systems
  - Best practices defined during the Regions RFP and implementation process can be shared
  - As desired towns can share forms, rules and processing capabilities developed in other towns

- 7. No Risk for Signing the Grant Application:
  - No commitment to spend dollars
  - No commitment to use the solutions to be identified during the RFP process by the towns (solution to be picked by the towns)
