Request from the Beach Committee

To Chilmark Board of Selectmen,

First, as a point of clarification, this request is separate from and not related to the complaint made by an individual about the HRBC's conduct at their meetings.

The Beach Committee is asking the selectmen to reconsider their decision made at their meeting of February 5th to require Martina Mastramonoco, beach superintendent, to pass the lifeguard certification test by this July 1.

The committee feels that their evaluation of the superintendent which included the goal to obtain her certification by May 2014 should be honored by the selectmen. The beach committee approved this evaluation. Martina signed the evaluation with the understanding that these were the terms. Her evaluation was given to the HRBC as required.

Our main priority now is to get the beach department up and running for this summer.

The Beach Committee will change the deadline to earlier in the year of 2014, rather than May.
