Hillside Village 1 Vineyard Haven, MA

Hillside Village 1 consists of 40 subsidized apartments. The funding is through USDA Rural Development, Sec. 515 Rental Assistance Program for the elderly and non-elderly disabled. Currently, we are fully occupied; however, eligible applicants can be placed on our waiting list. To be eligible, applicants must be 62 years and older or disabled and fall within the following income eligibility limits:

Very low:	1 person - \$31,350	2 persons - \$35,800
Low:	1 person - \$47,200	2 persons - \$53,950
Moderate:	1 person - \$52,700	2 persons - \$59,450
