SUBJECT: ZBA Special Permit Decisions and Applications

This summarizes the decisions reached at the January 29, 2014 ZBA meeting and outlines the agenda for its February 26, 2014 meeting.

## January 29, 2014 Decisions:

- 1. <u>APPROVED: CHRIS ALLEY FOR I FOUND MY THRILL, LLC Article 4 Section 4.2A3; 74 North Rd.</u>; <u>Map 3 Lot 2</u>: Construct a built-in swimming pool and spa that is approximately 65' X 18'. The property's old built-in pool was removed. The new pool will have an auxiliary heat pump pool water heating system and use a four-foot high stone wall and sides of the house as the safety enclosure. Ground-mounted photovoltaic panels will produce power to offset the pool equipment electricity needs. The pool equipment will be located in a sound-insulated shed.
- <u>APPROVED: STEPHANIE DAROSA; Variance to Article 6 Section 6.9B.3.a.; 9 Swan's Way; Map 11</u> <u>Lot 69:</u> Seek a Variance to create an Affordable Homesite Housing Lot whose area is approximately 171 sq. ft. less than the minimum one-acre as specified for a Homesite Housing Lot. If approved, the applicant will meet with the Board of Health as needed.
