All Shellfish Growers,

This letter is to remind you that all persons growing shellfish need an aquaculture permit issued annually by the Division of Marine Fisheries. This permit is necessary to possess seed shellfish and conduct activities related to shellfish culture even if you do not plan to purchase seed shellfish during the upcoming year.

Although Division permits are issued on a calendar year basis, shellfish aquaculture permits are good through April 15 of the next calendar year.

Please complete the Private Aquaculture Permit Application and Private Shellfish Aquaculture Report. Permits should be renewed as soon as possible and may be amended at any time at no additional charge. The renewal period for all persons holding a private aquaculture site (aka grant) is April 1, 2014. If applications for renewal are not received by that date then the shellfish growers name will be referred to both the local shellfish constable and the state environmental police for follow up action.


Also enclosed you will find a 2014 Seed Transplant Report form that should be completed and returned to *Marine Fisheries* by December 1, 2014.

The following is a reminder to all shellfish growers. Private culture of shellfish in coastal waters may only be conducted on a site licensed (grant) under authority of Chapter 130, section 57 of Massachusetts General Laws (MGL). This applies to intermediate seed grow out in flupsys or floating upwellers and to over wintering of seed. Intermediate grow out and over wintering of seed in coastal waters may only be conducted on the growers licensed site or an alternative site licensed by the municipality in accordance with section 57, MGL for these purposes, such as a community site.

Land based upwellers or upwellers on a dock are allowed and can be covered by the *Marine Fisheries* Aquaculture Permit.
