Everyone here at Virtual Towns & Schools would like to thank you for your business this past year.

2013 Results: We are very pleased to report last year was our 3rd record year in a row for new contract revenue – up 40+% over 2012's record. We signed 55 new clients, grew to 11 clients in our first year in the PA market, completed two significant expansions in our Data Center, and passed the 450 total client mark. Additional new staff were hired to support our big plans for 2014. More specifically:

FirstClass CMS: We've made good progress rolling out, at no cost,a mobile version for VTS FirstClass websites. This process must be done one client at a time; we expect completion during the first quarter of this year. We continue to add new FC clients and a large number of longstanding clients completed custom redesign projects updating their website "look & feel" (including widening the design footprint and new navigation to reduce the number of "clicks" it takes from the homepage to desired content).

Alternate CMS: Our "Post & Go!" CMS is built on Drupal – by far the leading Open Source platform for the public sector websites – saw significant expansion last year. Drupal powers thousands of large government websites in the U.S. and around the world. VTS's Post & Go! is browser based and has been customized for local governments. Additional Application Services: A number of clients chose our new Board & Committee module and we also released a new website on the increasingly hot topic of Government Website Transparency (which includes no cost suggestions to improve transparency as well as more sophisticated applications like "Open Checkbook").
