I propose the Town adopt the following replacement cycle for the police cruisers. In the first third of the cycle, one of the three response cruisers will be replaced each year for three years. Once all three response cruisers are replaced, there will be a year off where the Town will not replace any cruisers. In the second third of the cycle, the two oldest response cruisers will be replaced over two years. The third remaining response vehicle will be kept and maintained as a backup cruiser. The following year the unmarked cruiser will be replaced, followed by another year off. From here the last third of this cycle will be repeated as the first cycle. This cycle will result in each response cruiser being replaced every five to six years and allow the Town a year off every three years from purchasing a cruiser.
