Good Morning Tim,

At the ATE on Wednesday, in the office of Finance Committee, Susan Murphy received 241 votes to win re-election for a three year term. Linda Coutinho won the most votes as a write-in (3) for the second position open on the Finance Committee. As far as I am aware, Linda is not planning on re-joining the Finance Committee. The person with the second highest number of write-in votes was Eric Glasgow (2).

Since Jim Malkin was elected to the Board of Selectmen, an additional seat on the Finance Committee has become vacant. Four people received one write-in vote each for Finance Committee:

Mary Boyd
Katherine Carroll

For the office of Surveyor of Wood, Lumber & Bark, the write-in candidate with highest number of votes was Keith Emin (9). However, Keith already occupies a position in this office which expires in 2017. The person with the second highest number of write-in votes was Sam Feldman (5).

Sam Feldman won re-election to the office of Fence Viewer with 37 write-in votes.
