- 3. Contact Chief Thomas Levy at Bridgewater Fire Dept. (508) 697-0913 or Superintendent Rob Kenn at the East Bridgewater DPW (508) 378-1620) to borrow any of the equipment.

The Cache site is located at 774 Plymouth Street, Bridgewater, behind Fire Station #2. An open house is planned for October 2016 with additional details about this event coming soon. Please plan to attend, tour the new storage shelter and see the new emergency response equipment.
