<b>Malkin</b>	<b>2017</b>	Write-In candidate for a Three Year Term on 4/20/2014 (Catherine Thompson was elected for a Five-Year Term on 4/25/2012, resigned on 12/9/2013 and Malkin filled the remaining years of the position.)	
<b>Weidner</b>	<b>2018</b>	Elected on 4/28/10 to a three year term, elected on 4/30/2013 to a Five-Year Term.	
<b>Osness</b>	<b>2019</b>	Elected on 4/30/2014 to a Five-Year Term.	
<b>Eisner</b>	<b>2020</b>	Elected on the ballot for an open 5 year position (John O. Flender retired) on April 29, 2015.	
<b>Posin</b>	<b>2021</b>	Elected on 4/27/2011 to a Five-Year Term	
<b>MacLeod</b>	<b>2021</b>	Greenbaum resigned in October 2015, C. MacLeod appointed 12/2016 to remainder of term. Greenbaum's 5 yr term expires 4-27-16 (elected as write-in in 2011)	
<b>Hart</b>	<b>2021</b>	Elected on the ballot for an open 1 year position (Andrew Orin Fischer retired) on April 29, 2015. Andrew's 5 yr term expires 4-27-2016	
<b>Flender</b>	<b>2015</b>	Elected on 4/28/2010 to a Five-Year Term, retired April 2015, Eisner ran and won this 5 yr. position in Apr 29, 2015.	
<b>Fischer</b>	<b>2016</b>	Write-In candidate for a five Year Term on 4/27/2011. Resigned on 11/21/2014 and a One Year Position will be on the ATE 2015 ballot, 5 yr on 2016 ballot	
<b>Greenbaum</b>	<b>2016</b>	Write-In candidate for a five Year Term on 4/27/2011. Resigned in October 2015--MacLeod appointed to remainder of term in Dec 2015. 5 yr pos on 2016 ballot

<b>Carroll</b>	<b>2017</b>	(Re-elected at ATE 2014 for a three-year term)
<b>Divoll</b>	<b>2018</b>	Ran for an open three year term and was elected at the ATE on April 29, 2015.
<b>Debettencourt</b>	<b>2018</b>	Ran as a write-in for a three year term and was elected at the ATE on April 29, 2015.
<b>Golden</b>	<b>2018</b>	Ran for re-election for a three year term and was elected at the ATE on April 29, 2015.
<b>Murphy</b>	<b>2019</b>	Ran for an open one year term and was elected at the ATE on April 29, 2015. Ran in 2016 and won a 3 year position.
<b>Glasgow</b>	<b>2019</b>	Elected as a write-in in 2016 (Coutinho received more votes as a write-in but did not accept position)
<b>?</b>	<b>2017</b>	Appointed at a joint meeting of the BOS/FinComm on Nov. 29, 2016
<b>Yeomans</b>	<b>2015</b>	(Re-elected at ATE 2012 for a three-year term) Did not seek re-election in 2015
<b>Coutinho</b>	<b>2016</b>	(Write-in for a 3 yr. pos. at ATE 2013 & accepted position) Did not seek re-election in 2016
<b>Malkin</b>	<b>2017</b>	(Chidsey, write-in candidate at ATE 2011 for a 3 yr. pos., resigned on 11/18/2013. James Malkin was elected to replace Chidsey by BOS in winter 2013-14 and served until the ATE 2014. Malkin was elected to a 3 yr. term at ATE 2014.) Elected to BOS in 2016 and resigned as a FinComm Member. BOS& FinComm held joint meeting on Nov. 29, 2016 to appoint a person to serve until April 26, 2017.
