I was also a 40 year plus member of the Boxford Democratic Town Committee, serving as its Chair for about 15 years. Among my other professional commitments, I was a consulting psychologist at the Island Counseling Service of Martha's Vineyard Community Services for about 5 years. I retired on June 30, 2016, from all my professional responsibilities and would like to continue my commitment to community service here on the island.
