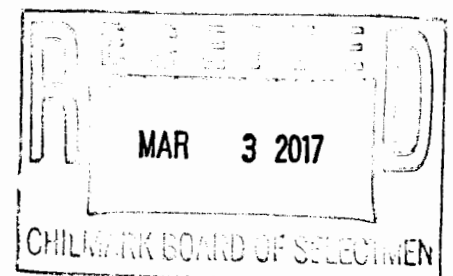

Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131 Section 40 requires any person filing a Notice of Intent with a conservation commission give notification to abutters. *Town Pond*

As such an abutter please note that a Notice of Intent has been filed with the Chilmark Conservation Commission on behalf Robert Alden to repair and maintain an existing walkway and pier on Stonewall Pond. The proposed work is located at 140 State Road, Assessor Map 33, Parcel 17, Chilmark, MA.

Copies of this Notice of Intent are on file with the Chilmark Conservation Commission at the Town Hall. For more information or to examine copies contact the Conservation Commission at the Town Hall (508)-645-2114 or this office.

At least 5 days before the public hearing, a legal notice will be published in a local paper.
