## **BAY SCALLOP SEASON**

## 2017/18

-Commercial Fishing Days - Monday thru Friday (7:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M.)

-Commercial Limit - Two (2) Struck Bushels per Day (Shrimp baskets or rectangular boxes allowed).


-Check in at Menemsha Harbor or Quitsa Bridge no later than 4:10 P.M.

### <u>Menemsha Pond</u>

-Commercial Season-Commercial harvest of bay scallops from Menemsha Pond begins on December 1, 2017 (See Map).

#### Nashaquitsa & Stonewall Ponds

-Commercial Season-Commercial harvest of bay scallops from Nashquita & Stonewall Ponds begins on November 20, 2017 (See Map).



- Certain areas of Nashaquitsa will be closed for the entire commercial season to protect eelgrass restoration.
- Each of these areas will be marked by a line of buoys similar to a swim line.
- To further protect these areas there will be no recreational dragging in Nashaquitsa. All other areas will be opened for dragging.
- Dip netting only for recreational harvest in Quitsa.

### **Recreational Bay Scallop Season**

No dragging allowed in Nashaquitsa (Dip net only for the entire season). All other areas are open for dragging.

-Family/ Recreational Season starts October 1, 2017 (One half (1/2) bushel per week).

## **OYSTER SEASON**

### 2017/18

#### **Commercial Oyster Season-Tisbury Great Pond**

-Commercial Oyster Season - in Tisbury Great Pond begins November 1, 2017.

-Commercial Limit - 800 count limit per day.

-Commercial Fishing Days - Fishermen may harvest oysters only three (3) of the fishing days in a given week. Monday thru Friday (7:00 A.M.-4:00 P.M.) Communication to the Shellfish Constable of what days a commercial harvest takes place will be the responsibility of the permit holder. Acceptable communication is a text message or phone call.

-Check in at Old Coast Guard Station no later than 4:10 P.M.

**Recreational Oyster Season-Tisbury Great Pond** 

-Family/ Recreational Oyster Season- in Tisbury Great Pond begins November 1, 2017.

-Family Limit- One Half (1/2) Bushels per Week.
